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**PART I** MHA is providing this addendum to answer questions that have been raised about this solicitation. To aid in readability, the questions are in black and the answers are in **bold** and the answers follow immediately below.

Q1	Will soil compaction be tested?
	<b>Yes, soil compaction will be tested. Please see the project manual for specifications.</b>
Q2	Will an independent testing company test for compaction?
	<b>Yes, the owner will engage and pay for a qualified independent geotechnical engineering testing agency to perform field quality-control testing on each area of the work.</b>
Q3	What are the noise and work hour restrictions for the project?
	<b>The City of Murfreesboro Noise Control Ordinance shall govern work hours and permissible sound levels. The summary of restrictions can be found at <a href="https://www.murfreesborotn.gov/DocumentCenter/View/7039/Noise-Control-Ordinance---Restriction-Chart?bidId=">https://www.murfreesborotn.gov/DocumentCenter/View/7039/Noise-Control-Ordinance---Restriction-Chart?bidId=</a></b>
Q4	Will utilities be cut and capped prior to demolition?
	<b>Existing water, sewer, gas and electrical service to buildings shall be cut off and capped arranged by Owner under separate contract. It is the responsibility of the supplier to verify all utilities are disconnected prior to starting work.</b>

**PART II** MHA has revised the Oakland Court Phase One Demolition Plans to exclude the demolition and abatement of the existing building located at 302 East Lokey Avenue. The revised total number of buildings to be abated and demolished in Phase One is 26. The revised demolition drawings are posted on the owner's webpage and are included in this addendum. Any references in the Solicitation Documents to be revised to reflect 26 buildings.

**PART III** MHA has revised the Solicitation Document Item 13. General Instructions to Bidders as follows.

13. General Instructions to Suppliers

An Invitation for Bids (IFB) is issued which includes the specifications and all contractual terms and conditions applicable to the procurement, and a statement that award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder whose bid meets the requirements of

the solicitation. All bids must be delivered to the Murfreesboro Housing Authority at 415 Maple St. Murfreesboro, TN 37130. All bids received will be dated, time stamped and stored unopened in a secure place until the public bid opening. Bids may be submitted via courier or shipping service provided they are received by the bid deadline of 12PM (Central Standard Time) on February 11th, 2020. A bidder may withdraw their bid at any time prior to the bid opening.

**PART IV** MHA has revised the Solicitation Document Item 31. Time of Completion as follows:

31. Time for Completion

Once MHA issues the notice to proceed, the supplier shall complete the Work not later than 90 days from the date of the notice to proceed.

**PART V** MHA has revised the following items to this solicitation document.
